WHEREAS there is a group in our community, the Transplant Advocate Association (TAA), whose volunteers are dedicated to the support of pre and post-transplant recipients, donors, their families and caregivers, and to informing the public of the important need for organ & tissue donation, and

WHEREAS many Canadians are awaiting organ or tissue transplants despite the increase in organ donations and still, many die waiting each year, and

WHEREAS Logan Boulet's (crash victim and organ donor) family, the TAA, the Trillium Gift of Life Network, and the Canadian Transplant Association carry on Logan's legacy by encouraging everyone to wear green on the anniversary of his donation and throughout April to raise awareness of organ & tissue donation, and the need to register consent to be an organ and tissue donor, and

Whereas the above groups encourage everyone to make their families aware of their wishes when they register their consent to be organ and tissue donors;
