

# Town of Greater Napanee Council Highlights

Regular Meeting of Council for May 14, 2024

## IESO Procurement Update

The Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO) released the results of battery storage projects selected during the procurement process. Of the four projects that received supportive resolutions from Council on November 28th, only the natural gas expansion at the Napanee Generating Station was selected. No BESS projects were awarded in this round of procurement in Greater Napanee. Atura Power is hosting a public meeting for the project on May 16th as part of their engagement process. ## Proposed New Advisory Committee Update

A decision on a new committee will be deferred to one of the July Council meetings. Deferring the decision will allow the new CAO to be involved in the discussion around the new committee structure and mandate. This will also give staff additional time to gather information on effective models from other communities and the local needs that the proposed committee could best support. The allocation of the \$15,000 that was provided to the Downtown Advisory Committee will be determined at the same time as the committee mandate.

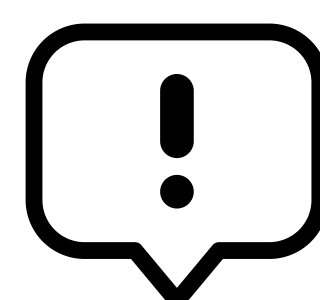
